SESSION HIGHLIGHTS – APRIL 12, 2017

- Seven Session members were present: Joe Bennett, Tom Byrnes, Eddie Coggins, Marguerite Fowler, Phil Griffin, Sue Langfitt, Jim Moore, and Moderator, Jennie Hemrick. Julie Tyson was in New York.
- There was a question raised regarding acknowledgements of receipt of Memorials. Process is to include: Memorials recognized for every member, thank you notes sent to giver, notification provided to family member.
- B&G: All thermostat timers have been changed for Saturday now that Seventh Day is no longer using the facility. LED lighting is on order (see related article below). For any ant problems in the kitchen, e-mail or call Carole to contact our exterminator—Go Forth Pest Control.
- Christian Education has scheduled an Easter Egg Hunt on the church front lawn Easter Sunday. The combined Sunday School class will review Reformation. Due to the need for a back seat in the van for youth activities, Phil contacted insurance company to change the coverage; insurance increased \$70/year.
- Service reported a decrease in food pantry poundage compared to last year. The Meal of Grace will be May 5th at 5:00 pm.
- The Witness committee will set up on the front lawn for Memorial Day festivities.
- Worship has searched and found a pianist/organist replacement (see related article, page 1). Yulia will be away this summer beginning May 28 for 9 Sundays.
- OLD BUSINESS: Reviewed status of Community Fun Day, May 13, 2:00-5:00 pm. There was further discussion about Christmas Parade to outline project needs and who will/can handle. There is a need to build a team for the A/V system. Mitch Tyson is in training for this task, but we need two or three more so no one person has the responsibility every Sunday.
- NEW BUSINESS: Jennie's headset sound quality is poor. Further review indicated that the sound board had been changed, which caused the problem. Jennie is scheduled to be away Monday, April 17-20, 2017. By April 30, a congregational meeting will be scheduled to elect an Elder to fill our vacancy. Sue Hunter is developing a program for Newcomers to Thomasville, to meet on Monday mornings at 9:00 or evenings at 7:00. The group will share coffee, "goodies," and conversation. Additional information coming soon. A Social Media Marketing Conference will be held on May 25 at the Holiday Inn in Greensboro from 9:00-4:00 if anyone is interested.

FROM BUILDING & GROUNDS

The entire church lighting is now converted to LED. Lights were installed under a Duke Energy sponsored rebate program. Even lamps in the parlor are now LED. Most importantly from a maintenance and cost reduction standpoint, all 118 fluorescent fixtures now are ballast-free with approximately 70% power savings and 15% increase in Lumen output. Also, all lights are under warranty with expected life of twenty-two years. Enjoy basking in the light!
